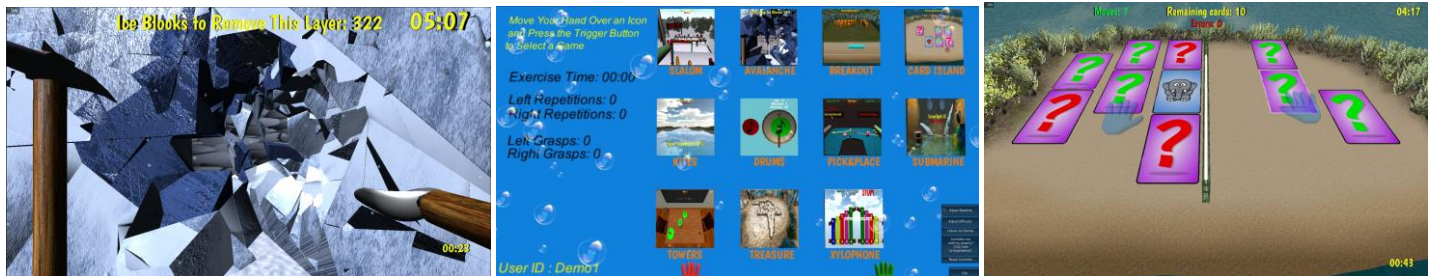


Protocol 10-001



Volunteers Needed for Evaluation of a Novel Virtual Rehabilitation Program

Would you like to try computer games that help improve arm movement, strength, memory, attention, decision making and well-being? If yes, you can take part by testing a virtual reality system at Commercialization Center for Innovating Technologies (675 US Hwy 1, North Brunswick, NJ 08902). The study has been approved by Western Institutional Review Board.

Study details

- You will be reimbursed \$25 at the end of each of 4 sessions over 2 weeks;
- You need to be generally healthy and between 50 and 80 years of age;
- You will attend four one-hour sessions at CCIT Suite B203 (parking is free);
- You will train both arms and your mind while playing new therapeutic video games;
- You will provide researchers feedback about your impression of the experimental system so they can improve it.
